As a composer, Motoki's works have been performed and premièred in venues such as Carnegie Hall (NY); Wigmore Hall, Southbank Centre, Barbican Centre, Cadogan Hall, St. John's Smith Square, Unicorn Theatre.

He was born in Tokyo into a highly gifted musical family and studied piano and composition with his grandfather Kozaburo Hirai, legendary composer of folk music master pieces such as "Tombo-no-Megane".
